**Re: Notice - Water Restrictions Lifted - WILD Water System**

Further to earlier correspondence, commission crews have been working to repair the line break which was referenced during our April 11<sup>th</sup>, 2022 notice to members. At this time, we have isolated the break and have arranged a temporary bypass allowing the system to be brought back on-line. As of 9:00 A.M. on April 13<sup>th</sup>, 2022 the system is operating at normal capacity.
